Don't forget to renew your SCC membership! Simply go to the website at <a href="https://members.scconline.org/">https://members.scconline.org/</a> to pay your dues. If you have activated your account and have created your own login and password, simply login. If you have not activated your account you need to do so before proceeding to pay. This is a great way to handle your dues while working from home.
