



Banana Bread

Ingredients

2 large, very ripe bananas

1 stick cold butter, cut into 6 or 7 pieces

1 1/2 cups of all purpose flour

3/4 cup sugar

2 large eggs

3 TBS lemon juice

1/4 cup of milk

1 tsp baking powder

1/2 tsp baking soda

1/4 tsp salt

1/4 to 1/2 cup roasted pecans

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Grease a loaf pan. Cut the bananas into large chunks and place

in a food processor bowl with the butter.

Process until mixed.

Add the flour, sugar, eggs, lemon juice, milk,

baking powder, baking soda and salt.

Process just until mixed – DO NOT

OVERMIX.

Add the pecans and process for 4-5 seconds. Pour into the prepared loaf pan and bake for

55 – 60 minutes until a wooden pick inserted in the center comes out clean.
