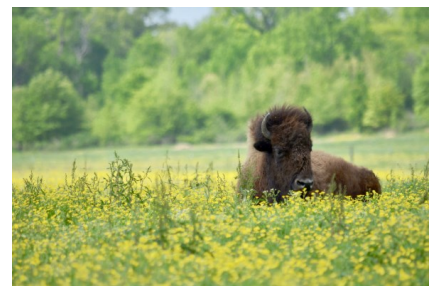
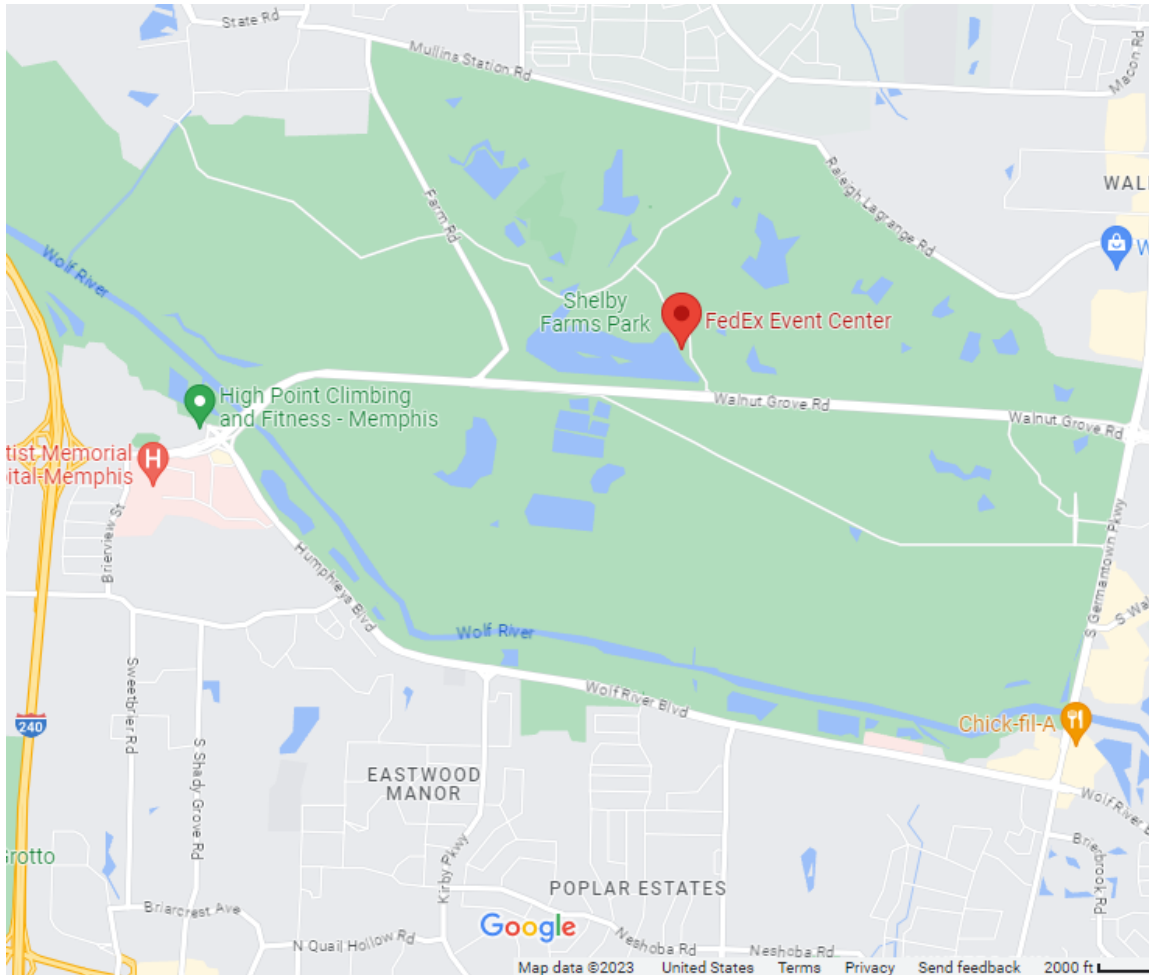

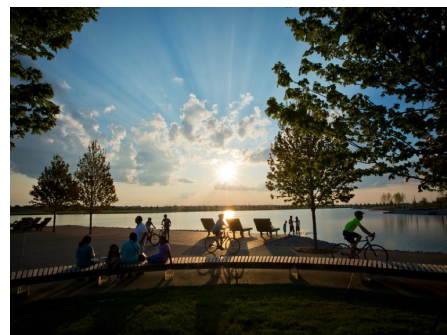
Driven Approach for Multifunctional Photoprotection".

The Southeast Chapter Needs You!

The Society of Cosmetic Chemists and the Southeast Chapter is built on volunteers. We are approaching the time when we need nominations (and/or volunteers) for our Southeast Chapter 2024 Officers and Committees. Please consider serving the Southeast Chapter as an officer or committee member for next year, so we can continue to provide programs that meet the needs of everyone in a Chapter that covers five states.

This fall, we will elect the following officers for the Southeast Chapter:

Chair-Elect – The Chair-Elect shall:

Assume the duties of the Chapter Chair in the absence or incapacity of the Chair.

Represent the Chapter at the request of the Chair.

Serve as an Area Councilor on the Society's Committee on Chapter Affairs (COCA).

Have such other powers and duties incident to the office of Chair-Elect and prescribed by the Chapter Board of Directors, the Executive Committee or these Bylaws.

The Chair-Elect for 2024 becomes the Chapter Chair in 2025.

Secretary: The Secretary shall:

Keep minutes of the meetings of the Chapter Board and the Executive Committee, as well as any business meetings of the Voting Members.

Oversee custody of and safeguard the Certificate of Incorporation and any other corporate documents of the Chapter.

Oversee the election process and certification of ballot results; or provide for same.

Have such other powers and duties incident to the office of Secretary and prescribed by the Chapter Board of Directors, the Executive Committee or these Bylaws.

Treasurer-Elect - The Treasurer-Elect shall serve one year as a learning term to become **Treasurer (a two year term) who Shall:**

Have power to disburse such funds of the Chapter as shall be required in the conduct of its affairs and the carrying on of its activities.

Have authority to sign any check, draft, or other order of the Chapter for the payment of money, unless otherwise ordered by resolution adopted by the Chapter Board or the Executive Committee.

Prepare financial statements for the Chapter Board and the Executive Committee in such form and frequency as they may direct.

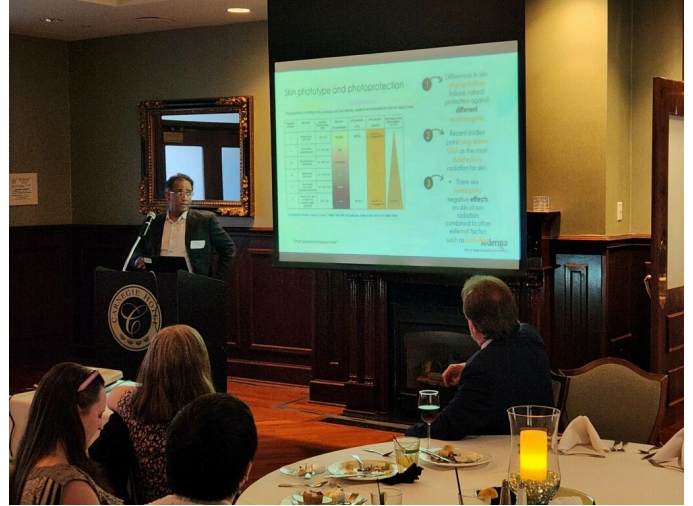
Oversee the custody and safekeeping of all monetary assets of the Society.

Prepare and submit the Chapters' Mid-Year and Year-End Financial Report submissions to the Society.

Attend the annual Treasurer's Meeting conducted by the Society.

Have such other powers and duties incident to the office of Treasurer/Treasurer-Elect and prescribed by the Chapter Board of Directors, the Executive Committee, or these Bylaws.

An excellent way to ease in to any of these offices is to serve on one of the Chapter Committees. As we continue to expand the geographic area where we hold our meetings, we need volunteers to help us locate venues and speakers that offer all of our members the programs and opportunity to attend in person and network with the variety of professionals that are a part of the Society of Cosmetic Chemists!

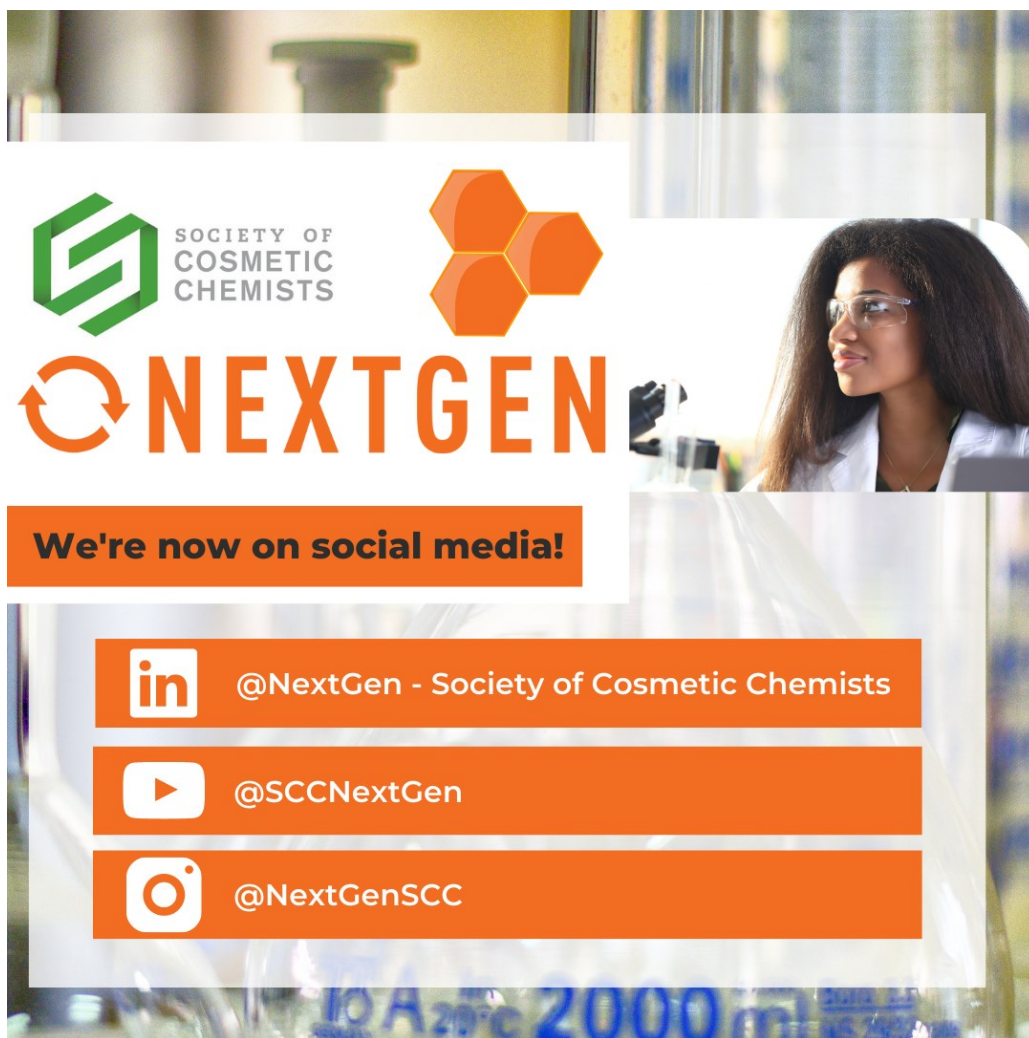
Botanicals and Naturals for the Naturals Market
