

Of course, we also encourage our entire community to save the date (30 October - 2 November 2016) and plan on attending the 29th Congress.



- 1. a sentence statement of the study's specific objective
- 2. brief statement of methods, if pertinent
- 3. summary of results obtained
- 4. statement of conclusions
