





Textured Hair: The Power of Curls

The topic of textured hair is providing an opportune time for brands to piggyback on and amplify the conversation. The greater acceptance of natural hair styles will increase demand for and interest in hair-care innovation for curly/coily textures. In Brazil, the US, and France, 53-79% of women describe their natural hair as curly. HOWEVER, only 6% of haircare launches in 2022 targeted curly/coily hair. These numbers show that consumers with coily/kinky hair remain underrepresented by mainstream brands and retailers. There are untapped opportunities within this haircare space to develop a complete range of curly/coily hair products to broaden reach for this market with a focus on treatments and styling lines. We will dive deeper into the difference between hair types and solutions for creating the best products for our curly/coily customers.

Jessica Wright has been a member of the Southeast SCC chapter since 2018. Her background is in chemistry where she started her career as a lab chemist at Chattem running every instrument to test raw materials and bulk/packaged products that came through the lab. After 3 years, she transitioned to an R&D position working as a formulation scientist working on oral care, OTC, allergy, and personal care brands. 


